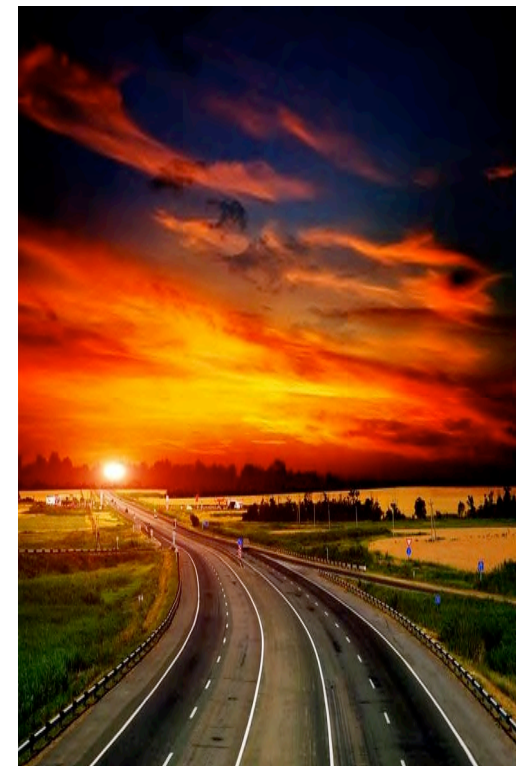

David Susman, Ph.D., Licensed Psychologist

Dr. Susman's session will explore foundational concepts of serious mental illness and recovery models. Specific inpatient recovery-based programs will be introduced so that outpatient clinicians are familiar with the types of programs their clients have received. Clinician resources for outpatient care will also be provided.

David Susman's Biography

Dr. Susman is the Psychological Services Director and Recovery Mall Director at Eastern State Hospital. He holds a Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology from the University of Kentucky. David is licensed in psychology by the KY Board of Examiners of Psychology. He is also an instructor at the university of Kentucky Department of Psychology.



Anna Duncan, Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor (LPCC), and Licensed Psychological Practitioner (LPP)

In Ms. Duncan's session, clinicians will learn about working with severe mental illness and recovery from an outpatient perspective, and how to specifically transition clients from hospitalization to outpatient care. Additional skills to use in outpatient settings, including practical tools, will also be provided.
